## **Measure Description:**

Increases share of moneys retained by Oregon Racing Commission from payments received by commission from gross receipts of mutuel wagering recorded by totalizator system.

## **Revenue Impact (in \$Millions):**

General Fund reduction of \$418,103 in 2015-17, and \$820,891 in 2017-19

## Impact Explanation:

This bill would change the percentage of distribution of revenue from Advanced Deposit Wagering Companies (ADW'). The current distribution directs 66 2/3% to the benefit of the industry and 33 1/3% to the General Fund (GF). The new distribution would be 85% to the benefit of the industry and 15% to the General Fund. This would result in a decrease in GF distributions.
