BACKGROUND:

Lenhart "Bud" Gienger passed away on March 4, 2014 after a lifetime of exemplary character, upstanding citizenship and community service.

Bud Gienger was born on November 11, 1935, in Tillamook, Oregon and attended Oregon State University (OSU). After graduating with a degree in agricultural business management he became president of Gienger Farms, one of the largest dairy farms in Tillamook. He also served as Chairperson of the Board of Directors of the Tillamook County Creamery Association and on the Board of Directors of the Tillamook County Pioneer Museum. He was deeply committed to giving back to his community, which included supporting OSU athletics with generous financial contributions and volunteering countless hours to educational and mentoring programs such as Start Making A Reader Today (SMART) and the Lunch Buddy program. He always exhibited love of family, boundless generosity, strength, tenacity and a commitment to making Oregon a better place for everyone.
