Requires Land Conservation and Development Commission to adopt administrative rules to implement statewide land use planning goal related to natural hazards.

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis: This bill would require the Department of Land Conservation and Development (DLCD) to adopt administrative rule to implement a statewide land use planning goal related to natural hazards. In addition, the bill would require DLCD to provide guidance to local governments regarding planning for reducing risk to people and property due to development in hazard zones. The bill also appropriates \$50,000 General Fund to DLCD to provide funding for rulemaking and to prepare guidance for local governments.

This bill requires budgetary action for the allocation of General Fund resources to DLCD and therefore requires a subsequent referral to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
