Measure Description: Moves the sunset of the hospital assessment from September 30, 2015, to September 30, 2019. Takes effect on passage.

Impact Explanation: The Oregon Health Authority estimates that the total anticipated revenue for the 2015-17 biennium is \$3,292.0 million (\$880.0 million from the hospital assessment matched by the federal funds of \$2,412.0 million). The total anticipated revenue for the 2017-19 biennium is \$3,966.0 million, with \$1,060 million coming from the assessment and the rest from the federal matching funds. The assessment is set to sunset on September 30, 2019.
