

FISCAL IMPACT OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION

Measure: HB 2394

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Measure Description:

Requires Director of Oregon State Lottery to provide information about lottery prize recipient to Department of Human Services within seven days after paying lottery prize of \$1,000 or more.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Human Services (DHS), Oregon State Lottery

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Human Services and Housing to the House Judiciary Committee. The bill requires the Director of the Oregon State Lottery to notify, within seven days of award payout, the Department of Human Services the name of prize recipients of \$1,000 or more, the Social Security number and identifying information as well as the amount of the prize paid to the recipient. The fiscal impact associated with this bill is still being determined. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the House Judiciary Committee.
