WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Requires Oregon State Lottery inform Department of Human Services within seven days after paying lottery prize of \$1,000 or more. Declares emergency; effective on passage.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:

No amendment.

BACKGROUND:

Section 4009 of the Agricultural Act of 2014, Public Law 113-79, requires the Director of the Oregon State Lottery to notify the Department of Human Services within seven days after paying a prize of \$1,000 or more. This notification must include the name of the prize recipient, the social security number of the recipient, any other available identifying information about the recipient, and the prize amount.

House Bill 2394 codifies a portion of federal law that requires the Oregon State Lottery to inform the Department of Human Services within seven days after paying lottery prizes of \$1,000 or more.
