Measure Description:

Modifies authority granted to owner of lot in planned community or unit in condominium to install and use electric vehicle charging station for personal, noncommercial use.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Consumer and Business Services (DCBS), Department of Energy

Local Government Mandate:

This bill affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis: This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Human Services and Housing to the House Committee on Energy and Environment. The bill modifies authority granted to an owner of a lot in a planned community. The agencies anticipate having a fiscal impact associated with this bill, the amount of this impact is still being determined. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the House Committee on Energy and Environment.
