**Measure Description:**

Expands rural health care income tax credit to include pharmacist services performed in rural areas.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Board of Pharmacy, Department of Revenue(DOR), Oregon Health Authority (OHA), Oregon Health Sciences University (OHSU)

**Local Government Mandate:**

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.
