**Measure Description:**

Provides that person commits crime of luring a minor if offense involves police officer posing as minor.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Department of Corrections, District Attorneys and their Deputies, Judicial Department, Oregon Criminal Justice Commission, Public Defense Services Commission

**Analysis:**

The proposed legislation has been determined to have
