**BACKGROUND:**

Linda Hornbuckle, world renowned funk and blues singer, passed away on October 4, 2014.

Hornbuckle, known for her pure and powerful voice, began performing at age six at Portland's Grace and Truth Pentecostal Church. Her natural talent propelled her into a world-renowned singing career. She toured and recorded with numerous artists including Quarterflash, Nu Shooz and Dan Reed. She was also influential in the Northwest music scene through her solo work. She won three awards from the Cascade Blues Foundation and was inducted into the Oregon Music Hall of Fame in 2010.
