Measure Description:

Expands definition of "emergency vehicle" in Oregon Vehicle Code to include vehicles operated by certain government agencies providing emergency services.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Cities, Counties, Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT), Oregon State Police (OSP)

Analysis:
