Measure Description:

Directs Department of Human Services to appoint advisory committee to advise department regarding policies and procedures to coordinate statewide planning for delivery of services to runaway and homeless youth and their families.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Human Services (DHS), Department of Justice (DOJ), Housing and Community Services Department, Oregon Health Authority (OHA)

Analysis:
