**Measure Description:**

Permits any person convicted of offense with relevant DNA evidence to file motion for DNA testing.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Department of Corrections, District Attorneys and their Deputies, Judicial Department, Oregon State Police (OSP), Public Defense Services Commission

**Analysis:**

The proposed legislation has been determined to have
