Measure Description:

Requires Oregon Business Development Department to establish programs for providing economic development assistance to persons engaged in business of western juniper harvesting or of manufacturing products from western juniper, for providing technical business assistance to western juniper harvesting and related manufacturing businesses, for providing or funding workforce training assistance for potential western juniper harvesting and related manufacturing business workers and for mapping and i

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW), Business Development Department (Business Oregon), Department of Agriculture, Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Department of Forestry, Employment Department, Cities, Counties, Special Districts

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Agriculture and Natural Resources to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. The bill appropriates \$800,000 General Fund (GF) to the Oregon Business Development Department and \$100,000 GF to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
