**Measure Description:**

Increases amount transferred from State School Fund to High Cost Disabilities Account each fiscal year.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

School Districts, Department of Education

**Summary of Expenditure Impact:**

**Local Government Mandate:**

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

**Analysis:**

The bill increases the amount of eligible expenses being reimbursed in the High Cost Disability Grant (HCD). Currently, the HCD is funded at \$18 million per year and the bill will increase this to \$35 million per year. These changes to the HCD will start with the 2015-16 school year. These changes are assumed in the Joint Ways & Means Co-Chairs Budget for the 2015-17 biennium; no referral to the Ways and Means Committee is necessary.
