Measure Description:

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon Department of Administrative Services for Oregon Healthcare Workforce Institute and Oregon Center for Nursing for analysis of effectiveness of state programs designed to encourage practice of healthcare providers with underserved populations or in rural areas.

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

Senate Bill 757 appropriates \$450,000 General Fund for the 2015-17 biennium to the Department of Administrative Services for pass through payments to the Oregon Healthcare Workforce Institute and the Oregon Center of Nursing to cover the cost of data collection and analysis of the performance and effectiveness of state programs designed to encourage healthcare providers to practice with underserved populations or in underserved or rural areas.

This bill requires budgetary action for the appropriation of General Fund.
