**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:**

Revises statutes to maintain accuracy. Corrects punctuation and grammatical errors. Conforms language to legislative style. Removes obsolete references, standardizes terminology, and replaces references to abolished state agencies. Makes other nonsubstantive corrections.

**ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- Contents of section notes
- Prior reviser's bills
- Intention is for nonsubstantive changes
- Review by attorneys and editors
- Contents of the measure

**EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:**

No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:**

Every session, the Office of Legislative Counsel introduces a "reviser's bill" to make nonsubstantive, corrective, and technical changes to Oregon law. Senate Bill 342 is the 2015 reviser's bill.
