**Measure Description:**

Requires Department of Human Services to convene work group to study consolidation of application processes for human and social services and to report recommendation to Legislative Assembly.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Department of Human Services (DHS), Oregon Health Authority (OHA), Department of Administrative Services (DAS), Housing and Community Services Department, Department of Education, Employment Department, Higher Education Coordinating Commission

**Analysis:**

The proposed legislation has been determined to have
