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Measure Description:

Permits Class I, Class II or Class IV all-terrain vehicles to be operated on highways under certain circumstances if equipped with certain equipment approved by Department of Transportation.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT), Oregon Parks and Recreation Department (OPRD)

Analysis:

The proposed legislation has been determined to have
