Measure Description:

Directs State Department of Fish and Wildlife to establish trophy trout lake pilot program.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW)

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis: This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Agriculture and Natural Resources to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. The bill introduces a new surcharge to angler's licenses and is estimated to cost an additional \$374,000 Other Funds and generate an additional \$890,000 Other Funds revenue. The agency anticipates having a fiscal impact associated with this bill, the amount of this impact is still being determined. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

Further Analysis Required
