Measure Description:

Establishes Oregon Spirits Board.

Revenue Impact (in \$Millions): This bill has a subsequent referral to the joint committee on ways and means. This statement is issued solely to assist in that referral.

Impact Explanation:

House Bill 2568 establishes the Oregon Spirits Board and provides funds to the Board from the sale of distilled spirits by the Oregon Liquor Control Commission that would otherwise have gone to the Oregon Liquor Control Commission Account. For every bottle sold, one to four cents will go the Board to support all aspects of the industry, including manufacturing, marketing, promotion, education, and research and development. This bill will be further analyzed as it moves to the committee on ways and means.
