Measure Description:

Changes name of "Oregon Liquor Control Commission" to "Adult Substances Control Commission."
Changes name of "Oregon Liquor Control Commission Account" to "Oregon Liquor Control Account."

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Oregon Liquor Control Commission (OLCC)

Summary of Expenditure Impact:

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

The bill changes the name of the Oregon Liquor Control Commission to the Adult Substances Control Commission. OLCC estimates that there will be one-time costs of \$47,400 to implement the name change, including replacing all agency forms, signage, branding, internet presence, and other items displaying the name of the agency.
