**Measure Description:** Allows an unemployed individual who is eligible for unemployment insurance benefits, to be still eligible for the benefits when the individual travels outside the normal labor market for job interviews. Takes effect on passage.

**Impact Explanation:** The bill allows an unemployed individual who is eligible for Unemployment Insurance (UI) benefits, to continue to be eligible for the benefits when the individual travels outside the normal labor market for job interviews. Under current law, the individual has to stay within the individual's normal labor market to be continuously eligible for benefits. This change will increase benefit payment, negatively affecting the UI Trust Fund.
