Measure Description:

Requires that fitness determination be conducted before hiring individuals with specified criminal history if individual will have direct contact with resident of residential facility or adult foster home or persons who receive in-home services or supports.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Human Services (DHS), Judicial Department, Oregon Health Authority (OHA),
Employment Department

Analysis:
