Measure Description:

Repeals state preemption of charter and statutory authority of local governments to set minimum wage requirements.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Cities, Bureau of Labor and Industries (BOLI)

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis: This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Business and Labor to the House Committee on Rules. The bill repeals the preemption of charter and statutory authority of local government to set minimum wage requirements. The agency anticipates having a fiscal impact associated with this bill, the amount of this impact is still being determined. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the House Committee on Rules.
