Measure Description:

Requires award of attorney fees to prevailing party on review of land use planning decisions.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Cities, Counties, Department of Land Conservation and Development, Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA)

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis: This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Rural Communities, Land Use, and Water to the House Committee on Rules. The bill requires award of attorney fees under certain circumstances. The agency anticipates having a fiscal impact associated with this bill, the amount of this impact is still being determined. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the House Committee on Rules.
