Measure Description:

Funds free transit passes for secondary school students residing in service area of Lane Transit District.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT), Special Districts

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis: This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Transportation and Economic Development to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. The bill funds free transit passes for secondary school students in the Lane Transit District. The agency anticipates having a fiscal impact associated with this bill, the amount of this impact is still being determined.
