Measure Description:

Requires contracting agencies to provide to Oregon Department of Administrative Services, and department to post on Oregon transparency website, certain information about public contracts.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Statewide

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Consumer Protection and Government Effectiveness to the House Committee on Rules. The bill modifies laws regarding public contracts, including requiring that certain information about public contracts be published on the Oregon transparency website and be subject to public records laws. The measure also requires specified meetings that must comply with public meeting laws. It is anticipated that there is a fiscal impact associated with this bill, but the amount of this impact is still being determined. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is further considered.
