Measure Description:

Establishes Working Forests and Farms Advisory Committee to provide advice regarding three new programs for maintaining or restoring conservation benefits of working forests and farms.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Business Development Department (Business Oregon), Oregon Watershed Enhancement Board (OWEB), Department of Administrative Services (DAS), Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW)

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis: This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Environment and Natural Resources to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. The bill establishes a Task Force on Working Forests and Farms. The agencies anticipate having a fiscal impact associated with this bill, the amount of this impact is still being determined. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
