Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis: This bill would increase the annual utility assessment from .0025 to .0030 and will increase PUC's cash flow in future biennia. This bill does not increase expenditures. This fee increase is included in the agency's budget request to the Legislature.
