**Local Government Mandate:**

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

**Analysis:** This bill establishes the Wildlife Public Education Advisory Council to advise the Fish and Wildlife Director on public education about wildlife. In addition, the bill establishes a surcharge on certain angling and hunting licenses issued by ODFW.

ODFW estimates that the increased staff time required to establish an appointment process for the Council and the time required to staff the Council would cost approximately \$40,813 in 2015-17.

Because the bill establishes a surcharge on certain angling and hunting licenses, the Legislative Fiscal Office believes this measure warrants a subsequent referral to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means Committee for consideration of this measure's budgetary impact on ODFW's budget.
