Measure Description:

Requires Oregon Health Authority to convene a stakeholder group to provide recommendations to the Legislative Assembly regarding the policy, operational and financial preferences of the group in the design and operation of a basic health program, in accordance with 42 U.S.C. 18051 and 42 C.F.R. part 600, by December 31, 2015.
