Measure Description:

Establishes the Task Force on Supporting and Improving Foster Parenting in Oregon

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Human Services (DHS), Legislative Assembly Judicial Department,

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting House Bill 311 from the Senate Committee on Workforce to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

Senate Bill 311 establishes the 14-member Task Force on Supporting and Improving Foster Parenting in Oregon charged with studying and making recommendations on foster care program quality and workforce issues related to the provision of foster care.

The bill is anticipated to have a fiscal impact on the Department of Human Services, the Legislative Assembly, and the Judicial Department. The amount of this impact is still being determined.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
