Measure Description:

Authorizes participant in peer support counseling session to waive confidentiality of communications made or information conveyed by participant in session.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Cities, Counties, Department of Corrections, Department of Justice, Department of Public Safety Standards and Training (DPSST), Oregon State Police (OSP)

Analysis:
