**Measure Description:**

Repeals statutes requiring industrial hemp growers and handlers to be licensed by State Department of Agriculture.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Department of Agriculture, Oregon Health Authority (OHA), Oregon Liquor Control Commission (OLCC)

**Analysis:**

The proposed legislation has been determined to have
