Measure Description:

Directs presiding judge of each judicial district to ensure all grand jury proceedings except for deliberations and voting are recorded verbatim.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Justice, District Attorneys and their Deputies, Judicial Department, Public Defense Services Commission

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

The measure creates procedures for and specifies limitations on, obtaining recordings or transcripts of grand jury proceedings. The measure directs presiding judge of each judicial district to ensure all grand jury proceedings, except for deliberations and voting, are recorded verbatim.
