

FISCAL IMPACT OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION

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Measure Description:

Requires transportation network company to maintain insurance policy to cover private passenger motor vehicle when vehicle's registered owner or designated operator actively participates as driver with transportation network company.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Justice, Department of Consumer and Business Services (DCBS), Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT)

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis: This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Transportation and Economic Development to the House Committee on Rules. The bill Requires transportation network companies to maintain insurance policies. The agencies anticipate having a fiscal impact associated with this bill, the amount of this impact is still being determined.
