Measure Description:

Authorizes issuance of lottery bonds to finance projects, related to removal of Mirror Pond dam, for purpose of improving habitat for fish and wildlife, restoring and protecting parks and promoting economic development.

Revenue Impact: This measure is referred to the joint committee on ways and Means by prior reference. This statement is issued to solely assist in that referral.

Impact Explanation:

The measure would authorize the State Treasurer to issue lottery bonds in the amount of \$5 million to the Bend Parks and Recreation Department to fund projects related to the removal of Mirror Pond Dam. A more detailed analysis will be conducted as the measure is considered by the ways and means committee.
