**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:**

Reinstates required contents of community health improvement plans developed by coordinated care organizations. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

**ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- Importance of incorporating school-based health centers in community health improvement plans

**EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:**

No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:**

Senate Bill 436, passed in 2013, required coordinated care organizations (CCOs) and community advisory councils to adopt health improvement plans that included the use of school-based health centers, to maximize resources at the local level and bring children's programs and providers together. Senate Bill 902 lifts the sunset on the requirement to include school-based health centers in community health improvement plans, to ensure continuing coordination.
