WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Establishes Oregon All Funds Crisis and Disaster Resourcing Task Force. Requires report to legislature by September 15, 2016. Sunsets December 31, 2016. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Funding for public safety systems in Oregon.

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:

No amendment.

BACKGROUND:

House Bill 3395 establishes the Oregon All Funds Crisis and Disaster Resourcing Task Force to examine sources of public and private moneys used to support public safety and security in Oregon; assess the value of existing taxes, fees and other moneys; evaluate outcomes resulting from these funding sources; and report to the legislature no later than September 15, 2016. The report may include recommendations for the design and implementation of a strategic resources structure to respond to future public safety and security needs.
