Appropriates moneys from General Fund to State Department of Fish and Wildlife for activities related to certain spring chinook salmon hatchery programs.

**Local Government Mandate:**

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

**Analysis:** This bill appropriates \$370,000 General Fund to ODFW to implement the Yaquina Bay and Coos Bay spring chinook program portion of the Coastal Multi-species Conservation and Management Plan.
