Measure Description:

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Department of Public Safety Standards and Training to provide students with opportunity to explore careers in law enforcement and to become familiar with law enforcement.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Public Safety Standards and Training (DPSST)

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Judiciary to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. The bill appropriates \$100,000 General Fund to the Department of Public Safety Standards and Training for the purpose of providing students in the fifth and sixth grades with the opportunity to explore careers in law enforcement and to become familiar with multiple aspects of law enforcement. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
