Measure Description:

Extends sunset for tax credit for contributions to Office of Child Care.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Education, Department of Human Services (DHS)

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Human Services and Housing to the Joint Committee on Tax Credits. The bill extends the tax credit sunset date for contributions to the Child Care fund through the Office of Child Care from 2016 to 2022. It is anticipated that there is a fiscal impact associated with this bill, but the amount of this impact is still being determined. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is further considered.
