Measure Description:

Transfers authority over health care facility structure plan review and inspections for fire and life safety from State Fire Marshal to Department of Consumer and Business Services or to municipalities having building inspection programs.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Consumer and Business Services (DCBS), Department of Human Services (DHS), Oregon State Police (OSP)

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis: This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Business and Transportation to the Senate Committee on Rules. The bill transfers authority over health care facility structure plan review and inspections from the State Fire Marshall to the Department of Consumer and Business Services. The agencies anticipate having a fiscal impact associated with this bill, but the amount of this impact is still being determined. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Senate Committee on Rules.
