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Measure Description:

Establishes penalty to be imposed by Employment Department on large employers whose employees receive health care coverage through medical assistance program.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Employment Department, Oregon Health Authority (OHA), Bureau of Labor and Industries (BOLI), Department of Consumer and Business Services (DCBS)

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Workforce to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
