Measure Description:

Requires minimum of 30 days' public notice and opportunity to comment period prior to meeting dates of regional solutions advisory committees.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Administrative Services (DAS), Office of the Governor, Business Development Department (Business Oregon)

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Rural Communities, Land Use, and Water to the House Committee on Rules. The bill requires a minimum of 30 days' notice and opportunity to comment before the date of regional solutions advisory committee meetings. The bill also extends the deadline to September 15, 2015 for the Governor and the Director of the Department of Administrative Services to develop this process. It is anticipated that there is a fiscal impact associated with this bill, but the amount of this impact is still being determined. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is further considered.

Further Analysis Required
