Measure Description:

Directs the Oregon Health Authority to develop a credentialing database operational no later than October 15, 2015. Requires the Oregon Health Authority to adopt by rule standards for determining whether information requested by a coordinated care organization from an organizational provider is redundant with respect to the reporting requirements for an assessment or if the information is outside of the scope of the assessment criteria.
