The revenue impact of this measure is indeterminate for the following reasons:

The measure allows for the establishment of predator damage control districts, the revenues from which would be used to support mitigation of damage to livestock or property from predatory animals including feral swine, coyotes, rabbits, rodents, and birds that may be destructive to agricultural crops. The permanent tax rate would be set on the petition to create the district, and is not meant to exceed \$1 per acre. The revenue from the establishment of these districts is unknown and would depend on the number of districts, the size of the assessment, and the acreage in the districts.
