Increases certain fees related to registering and titling boats, floating homes and boathouses.

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

HB 2459 is the fee bill for the Oregon Marine Board and would increase statutory fees to generate revenue sufficient to maintain Boating Safety and Boating Facility programs. These fee increases are anticipated to generate \$5.9 million Other Fund revenues and \$500,000 Federal Funds to the facility investment program.
