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Measure Description:

Establishes task force to investigate barriers to health insurance coverage.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Consumer and Business Services (DCBS), Legislative Administration Committee (LAC), Oregon Health Authority (OHA)

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting House Bill 2878 from the House Committee on Health Care to the House Committee on Rules.

The bill requires establishes the Task Force on Health Insurance charged with investigating barriers to health insurance coverage faced by Oregonians, and recommending actions to be taken to address the barriers.

The bill is anticipated to have a fiscal impact on the Legislative Administration Committee, the Department of Consumer and Business Services, and the Oregon Health Authority. The amount of this impact is still being determined.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the House Committee on Rules.
